3	SPARKFISH Presentation – by <u>Harriet Pearce</u> (Chair of Sparkfish)	
	Harriet gave a presentation on the work of Sparkfish (https://sparkfish.org.uk)	
	Sparkfish are a local, collaborative, Christian organisation that aims to inspire and encourage young people in faith, hope and love. They engage with young people in schools across Reigate, Redhill and Merstham, offering support in important areas of the curriculum and school life. Working as a team with local churches, they lead by example, lovingly demonstrating their own faith and supporting young people in all aspects of their lives. They work across all ages in education, from early years to sixth form and seek to bridge gaps and build confidence, helping young people to grow emotionally and spiritually.	
	The work Sparkfish engages in with schools is broadly split into 3 Strands:	
	Learn (e.g., RE events for schools which bring the Bible to life, and assemblies which explore values for life. These events include The Christmas Journey (for Y2 children) and The Easter Experience (for Y5 children).	
	Hope - Support for students at times of change and challenge through mentoring, courses and workshops.	
	Think - Space and time in a busy school for reflection and wonder, hopes and prayers.
